Bordeaux is a monumental, stylish city, full of elegant boulevards and well-preserved 18th century classical buildings. However, Bordeaux is also a prosperous, lively, modern city, a wonderful location in which to spend just a couple of weeks, or several months. The city is also an excellent base from which to explore South West France, right down to the Spanish border.

Our school is located in a chic district, right **in the heart of Bordeaux**. It occupies all 3 floors of a **beautiful 19th Century building**, with a large garden at the rear for the exclusive use of the students. There are 15 well-equipped, **spacious classrooms**, an Internet room, library, and students' lounge, which leads onto the **garden**. The staff are **exceptionally friendly** and organise a **wide range of visits**, activities and **excursions**.

These 1 or 2-week courses are specifically designed to prepare British students for the **French A-Level Examination and the GCSE exam**. The course runs during U.K. **half-terms** and **summer** school holidays. The course is held in **Bordeaux** in autumn, winter, spring and in **Biarritz** in the summer. There are **22 French lessons/week**, plus a **leisure activities programme**. The lessons are Monday-Friday 09.00 – 12.30. There are also 2 activities per week:

Bordeaux: Guided walk, French film, visit to Grand Theatre/Palais Rohan/Pyla Dune*.

Biarritz: Guided walk, museum trip, surfing/mountain bike tour/prehistoric cave visit* (*the exact details vary, depending on time of year and weather conditions)
