For young students wishing to study French in a truly 'Swiss' location, our 'French for Young Students' courses in **Leysin** and **Montreux** are the perfect choice.

The courses include **20 or 25 lessons/week** plus organised activities in the afternoon/evening, **1 full-day + 1 half-day excursion/week**.

Leysin (13-18 years) March-May/July-October. Full board, **on-site accommodation** with **24-hour supervision** in a stunning Alpine location in comfortable rooms with 2 or 3 beds and **private bathroom**. In **March-May**, students may also enrol on the **skiing** and **snowboarding** course, taught by fully qualified instructors. In March-May and July-October a wide range of other sports are also offered: volleyball, basketball, indoor hockey, badminton, table tennis, accompanied walks, swimming, skating, disco parties, football.
