Our school is located in the centre of Rome, just off the 'Piazza della Repubblica'. It occupies all four floors of a beautifully-restored detached residence. The school has a language laboratory and self-access study centre, both of which are available for students to use in their free time. The student snack bar and sun terrace at the back of the building are popular meeting points for students at break time and for lunch. The staff at the school are exceptionally friendly.

The school provides a full and varied programme of social activities in which the tutors participate, including excursions, guided tours, visits to concerts and the opera, films in the school, dinners and parties. Every week, outside normal class hours, seminars are held in the school, free-of-charge to students, on such subjects as 'The Italian Regions', 'Italian Cooking and Wine', 'Italian History', etc. There are also 'spaghetti evenings' in the school and visits to different parts of Rome, with tutors, each week.

Academic Year in Rome

This 32-week course is ideal for students of any level who wish to achieve fluency. As well as taking students to an advanced level in Italian, the course covers Business Italian, Italian Culture/History, Design and Art, so that students acquire not only fluency in the language but also a thorough understanding of Italian culture. By the end of the course the students will have taken the internationally recognised Italian examinations of CILS (University of Siena) and CELI (University of Perugia), a sufficient level to enter an Italian university. Accommodation is in self-catering apartments shared with other international students, or with 'Italian hosts' if preferred, or in Italian host families. Throughout their stay, students are provided with advice and personal assistance by the multi-lingual staff at our school. Students are also welcome to join in the wide range of activities, excursions, visits and seminars organised throughout the year by our school, including guided walks around Rome, and 'spaghetti evenings' (and parties in the school).

Students over 50 are more than welcome to join our normal courses. However, for those who prefer to be with people of their own age, we offer 'Club 50+'. The programme includes 20 Italian lessons/week, wine tasting and dinner evening, cookery lesson+meal, guided trips around Rome, seminars and excursions: Pompeii and Naples (exact programme varies week to week). Accommodation is in host families, hotels, private studios or sharing with 'Italian host'. Italian 'Club 50+' courses are also available in Florence, Elba and Milan.
